The Academic activities of the year started in full swing from 20th June, 1979. The College had on its rolls a strength of 4,377 in various classes. There were 75 faculty members. The college had 10 divisions of XIth Standard with a strength of 976 students and 9 divisions of XIIth Standard with 740 students at the Junior College level. The Junior College timings were from 1.20 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. At the Senior College level we had 7 divisions of F.Y.B.Com with a strength of 785 students and 10 divisions of S.Y.B.Com with a strength of 1,120 students and 6 divisions of T.Y.B.Com with a strength of 575 students. The College is also authorised to enroll students for M.Com and Ph.D.

Apart from these classes the college is also had four Semesters course of Diploma in Management Studies with a strength of 96 students.

In the extra curricular field, the college has a number of Organizations through which the students give expressions to their budding talents. The different associations live with each other to present better programmes to its members.

The college has a very well equipped Library Catering to the needs of the students and members of the Staff. The Library has been made up to date with the assistance given by the U.G.C. The Library has become a rich treasurer of knowledge from where our students and members of the staff draw information and inspiration.

The college provides a number of facilities for medical check-ups for various ailments to the students and members of the staff. A notable feature of our college, of which we are really proud of is the well-equipped Health Centre which looks after the health of the students, and the members of the staff. The Health Centre possesses an E.C.G. Machine, a Screening Machine, a Pathological Laboratory and a Dental Unit. Under the auspices of the Planning Forum a medical check-ups were conducted for T.B. and Cancer.

The flag of Lala Lajpat Rai College has been kept flying this year also by our students, in the inter-collegiate scene in Dramatics, "Group-Dances", in Elocution Competition and other extra curricular activities. Even in Social Service activities, our N.S.S. unit has proved that we are in the forefront by helping all worthy causes by collecting funds organizing camps, and cultural activities and by organizing Blood donation drives.

The staff and the students brought honour for the college by virtue of their distinguished and outstanding performances in the curricular and the extra-curricular activities. Several members of the staff have written books on their subjects which were well received and appreciated by the students and teachers of Bombay University.

Thus the curricular and extra curricular activities have secured a place of prominence for the college in the University of Bombay and has brought honour of being one of the leading institutions in the academic world of the metropolis.
