REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE  
COLLEGE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR - 1980-81

INTRODUCTION:

The academic year 1980-81 has been outstanding in the history of the college from the academic and extra curricular point of view. We are looking back with pride to an year of tremendous achievements in the extra-curricular fields and satisfactory performance in Academic field.

In the extra curricular field, the college has number of organizations through which the students give expression to their building Talents. The different Associations vive with each other to present better programmes to its members.

The College has a very well equipped Library cattering to the needs of the students and member of the Staff. The Library has been made upto date with the assistance given by the U.G.C. The Library has become a rich house of knowledge from where our students and members of the staff draw information and inspiration.

The College provides a number of facilities for medical check-ups for various ailments to the students and members of the Staff. A notable feature of our College, of which we are really proud of the well-equipped Health Centre, which looks after the health of the students and the members of the Staff.

The flag of the Lala Lajpat Rai College has been kept flying this year also by our students in the Inter-Collegiate and the National scene, scene in Dramatics, Group Dances, Elocution Competition and other extra Curricular activities. Even in Social Service Activities our N.S.S. Unit has proud that we are in the forefront, by helping all worthy causes by collecting Funds, Organizing camps and Cultural activities and by organizing Blood Donation Drives.

The academic activities of the year started in full swing from 20th June 1980. The College had on its rolls a total strength of 4067 students in various classes. There were 74 faculty members. The College had 9 divisions of XI standard with a strength of 900 students and 9 divisions of XII standard with 856 students in the Junior College level. The Junior College timings were from 1.20 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

At the Senior College level we had 7 divisions of F.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 628 students and 7 divisions of S.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 681 students and 9 divisions of T.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 913 students. The college is also authorised to enroll students for M.Com. and Ph.D.

Apart from these classes, the college also had four semesters course of Diploma in Management Studies with a strength of 71 students.
