REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE
YEAR - 1987 - 88

INTRODUCTION :

Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce and Economics is one of the leading educational institutions of the metropolis. Our achievements in the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular fields distinguish the college from other educational institutions of the city.

Lala Lajpat Rai college is one of the few colleges of Bombay University which has a well-equipped health centre. The health centre gets the services of some of the best doctors in the city. The centre carries out routine health check-up for students and members of the staff.

The college is also renowned for the Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial lecture service organised every year to commemorate the memory of Lala Lajpat Rai, the great patriot, men of eminence in the country have delivered lectures in these series.

The college has a well-equipped Library made upto date with the financial assistance given by the U.G.C. The Lala Lajpat Rai Library has turned out to be a rich treasure house of knowledge from where the students and members of the staff draw inspiration and information.

The academic activities of the college started in full swing from 20th June, 1987. The college has on its Roll a total strength of 3038 students in various classes.

The college has 8 divisions of XIth Standard with a strength of 733 students, and 7 divisions of XII standard, with a strength of 572 students, at the Junior college level. The Junior college timings are 1.00 p.m. to 5.20 p.m.

At the Senior college level, we have 7 divisions of F.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 660 students, and 6 divisions of S.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 598 students and 5 divisions of T.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 463 students. The college is also authorised to enroll students for M.Com. and Ph.D.

LALA LAJPAT RAI COLLEGE LIBRARY:


The college has a well-equipped Library which functions from 7.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. every day including Sundays and holidays.

1. Stock:- The college library added to its stock 870 books. The Library subscribed about 84 periodicals. ^{The} Total collection of books in the Library as on 31.3.1988 was 24680.

2. Timings:- The Library remains open between 7.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on weekdays and 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Sundays and holidays.

3. Services:- Besides regular issue of books and reference service provided for the students' activities, the following programmes were ^{also} organised for students.

A) EXHIBITIONS:- (i) Exhibition on Works by and on Mahatama Gandhi was organised on 1.10.87 and 2.10.87.

(ii)  Exhibition of Library books by and on 'Jawaharlal Nehru' and 'Indira Gandhi' was organised from 14.11.1987 to 18.11.1987.

B) LIBRARY ORIENTATION:- A Library orientation programme was conducted for students of Standard XI from 10.11.1987 to 13.11.1987.

C) VOCATIONAL GUIDANCE:- (i) 45 students were guided for Part-time/Summer Vacation employment (to the University Students) the programme organised by university Employment Information and Guidance Bureau.

(ii) 2 students got apprenticeship in Pfizer Ltd., under the apprenticeship Act 1961.

(iii) 4 students were sent for part-time employment at N.K.M. Institute, Bombay-400 020.

Health Centre :

1. The Health Centre examines approximately two to three thousand students every year and maintains their health records. However, this year the centre could examine only 878 students, as they were not available due to the long strike of the teaching staff.

However, the centre continues to extend investigative, diagnostic and consultation services to the staff and their families, besides the students. Whenever possible the centre also gives medicines to the staff and students.

In our tradition of Academic pursuit, the college organised a Seminar on "New Trends in Academic Librarianship" in collaboration with Indian Council Cultural Research, it was the exclusive zeal of our Librarian, Mrs. Powdwal, who collected experienced speakers of eminence like old and new Librarians, academicians and interested delegates/Librarians and assistant Librarians from other colleges. Some of the eminent speakers were Mr. S.S. Rege (Sidharth College) Mr. Anderson, Mr. A.C. Tikekar (Bombay University) and Mr. Subhash Waghre (British Council Library) besides Mrs. Hansa Parckh (SNDT) Library. Mr. Moghe. The Bombay University Vice-Chancellor, Ms. M.D. Bengalee delivered the keynote address.

As a new feature, the seminar made good use of audio visual aids both as surplus and contents. Certificates were issued to the participating delegates at the Plenary Session on the second day by Justice R.N. Gawade, who presided over the plenary session.

N.C.C.:

We direct our students for the N.C.C. Training Programmes held at the various institutions in the City of Bombay. During the academic year 1987-88, 25 students enrolled in N.C.C. and completed their N.C.C. training. The following cadets have achievements to their credits.

1. Shri Sudhir Pundit Pendhekar (F.Y.B.Com.) was selected as the best N.C.C. Cadet of the Naval Wing from our college.
2. Shri Boorzin Hodiwala (T.Y. B.Com.) has also been selected from as the best N.C.C. Cadet / among the cadets of Air Wing, from our College.

Shri Boorzin Hodiwala has to his credit the award of best Cadet for the second time during his career. He attended a number of N.C.C. Camps at the State as well as the national levels. He was selected as one of the forty-two, from all over India, to represent India at the Indo-Canada Youth exchange programme in Canada. In addition to this, he has been awarded certificates of merit for his social service, by the Maharashtra State (Agro Department) and National Association for the Welfare of rural women in India.
