REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR 1989-90

INTRODUCTION :

Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions of the metropolis. Our achievements in the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular fields distinguish the college from other educational institutions of the city.

Lala Lajpat Rai College is one of the few colleges of Bombay University which has a well-equipped health centre. The Health Centre gets the services of some of the best Doctors in the city. The Centre carries out routine health check-up for students and members of the staff besides treating the ailing ones.

The college is also renowned for the Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial Lectures organised each year to commemorate the memory of Lala Lajpat Rai, the great patriot. Men of eminence in the country have delivered lectures in these series on topics of Economic, Political, Educational and Social interest.

The College has a well-equipped library updated further with the financial assistance given by the U.G.C. The college library has turned out to be a rich treasure house of knowledge from where the students, members of the staff and even interested outsiders draw inspiration and information.

The academic activities of the college started in full swing from 20th June 1989. The college has on its Roll a total strength of 3202 students in various classes.

The college has 8 divisions of XIth Standard with a strength of 777 students, and 7 divisions of XII Standard, with a strength of 591 students at the Jr. College level.

At the Senior College level, we have 7 divisions of F.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 690 students, and 6 divisions of S.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 670 students and 5 divisions of T.Y. B.Com. with a strength of 465 students. The College is also authorised to enroll students for M.Com. and Ph.D.

Since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different aspects.

It has gained prominence and eminence among the colleges in south Bombay in particular as well as among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay in general.

Apart from pursuing academic excellence we promote an all-round general development of the students personalities by providing them ample opportunities in the fields of sports, performing arts debates, elocutions, and at any forum available to us. We learn as we go along and improve upon our failings and try our best to top in achievements and make amends as and when required.

The academics followed by the extra-curricular started off in full swing for the Senior and S.Y.J.C. from 20th June, 1989. The

total strength of the college as its roll bears out, is 3202, comprising 1368 in the Junior college and 1834 in the degree college.

THE ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR

1) Inauguration : The activities of the students council was formerly inaugurated on 21st September 1989.

2) Anti-Dowry Awareness Programme : On 5th July, 1989, the students council had organised an anti-dowry awareness programme in coordination with the college of social work, Nirmala Niketan, Bombay.
