INTRODUCTION

Lala Lajpt Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational Institutions of the metropolis. Our achievements in the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular fields distinguish the college from other educational Institutions of the city. Since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different aspects. It has gained prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay in general.

The College has an excellent building known for its modern architectural beauty. The structure stands like a towering personality facing the expanse of the Arabian sea and the shrines of Haji Ali and Goddess Mahalaxmi. There is no doubt that this College with its lofty structure has become a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai. The college building has sufficient number of spacious class rooms for imparting instruction to the students. It has a beautiful auditorium on the ground floor popularly known as Amar Gian Grover Auditorium. On the 3rd floor, it has College Office, a cultural hall, a gymkhana hall, a college canteen and a ladies' common room. On the same floor the students' council and the college co-operative stores have been provided functional accommodation. On the 2nd floor the college has its exclusive and well equipped library and the Principal's office. Prof. in-charge of the students' council, the gymkhana council and most importantly the examinations have been given rooms on the same floor to function effectively in their respective areas. Fourth floor provides class rooms for students and the Teachers Common Room. In addition to this, Profs. In-charge of the N.S.S. Unit, Gykhana and the Prof. In-charge of the Junior college have been provided rooms for carrying on their co-curricular and academic activities.

On the 6th floor the college has an enviable Health centre, which caters services to all the concerned students, teachers administrative and class IV staff. The honorary city doctors give their precious time to examine the concerned and prescribe the line of treatment for them, if necessary. The 5th floor has the regular lecture halls, and the research centre. This Research Centre functions under the exclusive control and guidance of Dr. B.R. Rairikar.

Lala Lajpat Rai Research Centre is one out of the three research Centres in the Colleges of Bombay.

14 Ph.D. students (Three of them have been submitted to University) and 14 M.Phil students have successfully completed their Ph.D. and M.Phil under the guidance of Dr. B.R. Rairikar.

College library has a collection of books which are very useeful and which are needed by the M.Phil and Ph.D students.

All the theses and desertations of Ph.D. and M.Phil students are available in the library for reference.

Dr. B.R. Rairikar has prepared and submitted 15 volumes of occasional papers covering various topics such as study of urban informal sector, planning for unemployment in Maharashtra etc. to the Library for reference. Altogether these contain 53 Articles.

Various papers have been sunbmitted by him at the conference held in Delhi, Goa, Lonawala and so on.

A report on voluntary arbitration, and analysis of case studies have been donated by Dr. B.R. Rairikar to the Library for reference which is prepared by him for Ambekar Institute of Labour Studies. He has published two monographs - one on part-time employment for women and other menial servants.
