INTRODUCTION :-

Lala Lajpat Rai college of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational Institutions of the metropolis. Our achievements in the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular fields distinguish the college from other educational Institutions of the city. Since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different aspects. It has gained prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay in general.

The College has an excellent building known for its modern architectural beauty. The structure stands like a towering personality facing the expanse of the Arabian sea and the shrines of Haji Ali and Goddess Mahalaxmi. There is no doubt that this College with its lofty structure has become a fitting memorial for the great son of India- Late Lala Lajpat Rai. The college building has sufficient number of spacious class rooms for imparting instruction to the students. It has a beautiful auditorium on the ground floor popularly known as Amar Gian Grover Auditorium. It also has a cultural hall, gymkhana hall, college canteen and the ladies' common room. On the 3rd floor the students' council and the college co-operative stores have been provided functional accommodation. On the 2nd floor the College has its exclusive and well - equipped library and the Principal's office. The floor also accommodates research facilities, college office, two computer LIBRARY and the Trust office. Professors in-charge of the students council, the gymkhana council and most importantly the examinations have been given rooms on the same floor to function effectively in their respective areas. The Fourth floor provides class rooms for students and the Teachers' Common Room. In addition to this, Prof.- In-charge of the N.S.S. Unit, Gymkhana and the Prof. In-charge of the Junior college have been provided rooms for carrying on their co-curricular and academic activities.

On the 6th floor the college has an enviable Health centre, which caters services to all the concerned students, teachers administrative and class IV staff. Matching with its traditions for excellence the College Library has now 28580 books on its shelves. In 1993-94 it added 429 books worth Rs. 25,303/-. It subscribes for 75 periodicals as well as all leading daily news papers.

THE BOOK BANK

The Book Bank of the College was established in the year 1974 with Prof. Hemant Wagh as its first Prof.- In-Charge. Since 1974 it has been extending help to the poor students of all the classes. The Book Bank has more than 2639 books to cater to the needy students. Prof. Mrs. V.V. Bhide is the Prof. in-charge of the Book Bank during the year.

Research Centre

Our College's research centre is one of the best of the three research centres among the colleges of Bombay.

Dr. B.R. Rairikar the former Principal of the Lala Lajpat Rai College is the Head and under his able guidance and erudite scholarship, as many as 16 Ph.D. Students and 14 M.Phil students have completed successfully their doctorate and M.Phil degrees, from the University of Bombay.

A majority of the thesis submitted are on the topics concerning labour and economics.

Our College Library is well equipped on these subjects and the books, journals and periodicals prove of invaluable help to the researchers.

Dr. B.R. Rairikar is the Head and guide of the research students;- himself, he has prepared and submitted 13 Volumes of occasional papers covering various topics such as; "STUDY OF URBAN INFORMAL SECTOR; planning for unemployment in Maharashtra, etc., to the library for ready reference. Dr. B.R. Rairikar has rendered valuable assistance to Mani Ben Kara in her writing on Exim Policy.

Papers have also been submitted at various conferences; some of which were on "Social Security of Women in Delhi" "Integration of Informal Sector into Formal Sector "Excellence in Education Goa".

The many-fold activities of the Research Centre has since its inception in the year 1976 contributed quite a great deal in its modest way. The centre hopes to pave the way for a greater and advanced sphere of research excellence in the academic world.

SEMINARS AND CONFERENCES

This academic year i.e. at the fag endlong end of 1993-94 the college organised a Seminar on "Union Budget 1994 and the Post Liberalisation Scenario (on 16th and 17th March, 1994).

Eminent personalities from their field of specialization were invited to express their views on the subject. The participants attending the seminar were from the city colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay.

The seminar was inaugurated by an eminent M.P. Shree Chimanbhai Mehta, former Minister for Human Resources Development.

The first Technical Session (i.e. on 16th) was presided over by Dr. D.M. Nachane Director of the Department of Economics University of Bombay.

The second Technical Session was presided over by Mr. Sunil Bhandare, Economic Advisor - Tata Consultancy Services. The Resource persons were Ranjita Patnaik from R.B.I., Mr. P.R. Krishna Murthy Executive Director, Bennett Coleman & Co. Dr. Ranjita Patnaik gave a very incisive analysis on the economic planning. Dr. D.M. Mithani Reader in the Department of Commerce University of Bombay read his paper in the Second Session of the first day of the Seminar. He was very critically analysed by Mr. Sunil Bhandare on the 17th i.e. the 2nd day of the seminar.

The 3rd Technical Session was presided over by Dr. M.Y. Khan Director, Department of Economics, Policy and Planning, Reserve Bank of India.

Mr. R.J. Mehta, President of the Kamgar Sabha was the first resource person for this session.

Dr. Guruprasad Murthy and Mr. Dhiren Mehta from the Jajmalal Bajaj Institute of Management Studies, and Prof. Malapur - Head of the Economics Department, Ismail Yusuf College contributed a fund of information through their papers.

The 4th Technical Session was presided over by Dr. (Mrs.) Malati Anagol, Head of the Department of Commerce, University of Bombay.

The Speakers for this Session were Mr. Krishna Raj, Chief Editor Economic and Political Weekly and Mr. S.V. Venkiteshan, Finance Director, Essar Group of Industries.

The valedictory Address was by Dr. Nayak Jt. General Manager Unit Turst of India.


