## INTRODUCTION :-

Lala Lajpat Rai college of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. Our achievements in the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular fields distinguishes the college from other educational institutions of the city. Since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different aspects. It has gained in prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay.

The College has an excellent building known for its modern architectural beauty. ### LALA LAJPAT RAI MEMORIAL LECTURE

The 24th Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial Lecture was delivered by Principal Ram Joshi Former Vice Chancellor University of Bombay and visiting Professor at the University of Texas U.S.A. On 3rd March 1995. He spoke on "Gandhian Philosophy in the Contemporary World".

The Memorial lecture was presided over by Dr. (Mrs.) Usha Mehta, a noted Gandhian and President of Gandhi Samak Nidhi Bombay. Dr. Mehta, lucidly summed up some of the aspects presented by Dr. Ram Joshi.

The Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial Lectures were instituted with the idea of perpetuating and rejuvenating the memories of the Great Patriots of India and to examine some aspects of our present day life with the factors Lajpat considered to be of prime importance for the nation building process.
