## INTRODUCTION :-

Lala Lajpat Rai college of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational Institutions in the metropolis ever since its inception in June 16, 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It has carved a niche for itself gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay.

The College has a towering personality facing the expanse of the Arabian sea with the shrines of Haji Ali, the famous temple of Mahalaxmi and the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has become a fitting memorial for the great son of India the Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab. The college at one time possessed a beautiful auditorium the Amar Gain Grover Auditorium on its ground floor, it has now been given over more to public functions and leading institutions that hold their seminars & conventions practically every Saturday the Auditorium is also lured by the Bollywood for film shootings.

The college has undergone many changes in its interior structure. On the 2nd floor, it houses the Principal's Office, the general Office, the Students Council Room for prof.in-charge, the two rooms for Computer practicals for both the new entrants and the S.Y. & T.Y. B.Com. students. The Library, the Reading Room & the Research Room along with the Principal's Residence are on the 2nd floor.

The canteen, the ladies common room for lady students, the college co-operative stores along with three lecture rooms are on the third floor of the building. Other lecture halls are on the 4th & 5th floors for the degree & Junior (XI & XII standards) college. The room for college teaching staff is housed in a cubby-hole near the 2nd lift on the fourth floor.

The third floor also houses an office for collection of fees and cabins for the Examination Work. The office of prof.in-charge of N.S.S. unit is on the 2nd floor the gymkhana unit is on the 4th floor. The College Health Centre is situated on the 6th floor.

The year 1995-96 witnessed a great deal of structural changes as the college was granted legal permission to introduce three Professional Courses viz The Management Course i.e.-M.M.S., The M.B.A. Foundation Course & the C.A. Foundation Course.

The seventh floor underwent a metamorphosis rooms were repainted restructured into. Library, Reading Room, Seminar Room, Lecture Room & the Director's Room along with his/her Secretary. A separate Gymkhana Room, Recreation Room & a Canteen is in the offing all for the Management college,


The College Health Centre, which enjoys the honorary services of some of the leading city practitioners ably guided by Dr. Naik (G.F.A.M.), who has been with us, since the centres inception is housed on the 6th floor of the building. The fifth

floor has lecture rooms as well as a Research Centre which functions under the exclusive control and guidance of Dr. B.R. Rairikar, former head of the institution.

## LALA LAJPAT RAI MEMORIAL LECTURE

The 24th Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial Lecture was delivered by Shri Suresh Prabhu - Chairman, Finance Commission, Maharashtra State. On Monday 29th January 1996. The topic of the Lecture was "Social Implications of the New Economic Policy". The lecture was presided over by Shreeman Kamal Gupta, member of the Governing Board of Lala Lajpat Rai Institute.

The Lala Lajpat Rai Memorial Trust had installed a Statue of Lala Lajpat Rai in the Municipal gardens at Haji Ali since 1993. It was finally unveiled by His Excellency Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma the Honorable President of India, on 8th January, 1996 in the Amar Gain Grover Auditorium due to security reasons. The garden incidentally was renamed "LALA LAJPAT RAI UDYAN" on the same day.

### COLLEGE LIBRARY :-

Matching with its traditions for excellence the College Library has now on its shelves 29345 books. During the year 1995-96 it added 662 books worth Rs. 1,21,741.32/-.

The Library Subscribes for 49 periodicals as well as all leading daily newspapers.

### THE BOOK BANK :

The Book Bank of the College was established in the year 1974. Since then it has been extending help to the poor students of all the classes. The Book Bank has more than 2683 books to cater to the needy students. Prof. Mrs. V.V. Bhide was the Prof. in-charge of the Book Bank during the year.

### Research Centre :

Our College's research centre is one of the best of the three research centres among the colleges of Bombay.

Dr. B.R. Rairikar the former Principal of the Lala Lajpat Rai College is the Head and under his able guidance and erudite scholarship, as many as 16 Ph.D. Students and 14 M.Phil students have completed successfully their doctrate and M.Phil degrees, from the University of Bombay.

A majority of the thesis submitted are on the topics concerning Labour and Economics.

Our College Library is well equipped on these subjects and the books, journals and periodicals prove of invaluable help to the researchers.

Dr. B.R. Rairikar - the head and guide of the research students;- himself, - has prepared and submitted 13 Volumes of occasional papers covering various topics such as; "STUDY OF URBAN INFORMAL SECTOR; planning for unemployment in Maharashtra, etc., to the library for ready reference. Dr. B.R. Rairikar has rendered valuable assistance to Mani Ben Kara in her writing on Exim Policy.

Papers have also been submitted at various conferences; some of which were on "Social Security of Women in Delhi" "Integration of Informal Sector into Formal Sector" "Excellence in Education Goa".

The many-fold activities of the Research Centre has since its inception in the year 1976 contributed quite a great deal in its modest way. The centre hopes to pave the way for a greater and advanced sphere of research excellence in the academic world.
