The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The building now has an added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since last academic year. Even since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It has carved a niche for itself gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Bombay.

The College has a towering personality facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Mahalaxmi and the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its twenty-five illustrious years of existence. The college was proud to possess for its very own use the Amar Gian Grover Auditorium for some years. It has now been given away more for public functions and leading institutions who hold their seminars and conventions every week-end. The auditorium is also exploited by the Bollywood and the management college.

The college has undergone many changes in the past two years. The college started with the management courses in the year 1995-96 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute - the degree college now playing a subservient role, the staff members shunted off to a cubby-hole of a room near the centre lift which is perennially "out of order."

On the 2nd floor of the building (the 1st floor being non-existent) is the Principal's Office, the general office, the student's Council room - Prof. in-charge the small passage houses 2 Computer rooms, the examination rooms, the Trust's honorary secretary Dr. Rairikar's room and the Principal's P.A. . At the other end of the floor the Library, Reading & Research Room. In the centre is Principal's private residence.

The Canteen, the lady students' Common room, Gymkhana, the college Co-operative stores, and two lecture rooms long with the fees collection centre are on the 3rd floor. The fourth and fifth floor are for the degree and junior college lecture rooms. The fourth floor also has the Staff Common room.

The sixth and seventh floors are for the Management Institute which conducts three professional courses : the M.M.S., the M.B.A.. Foundation Course and the C.A. Foundation course as well as the I.C.F.A.I. external courses.

The seventh floor comprises of the Management Library, the Reading room, The Seminar rooms, the Director's Office.

The College Health Centre which enjoys the honorary services of the City's leading practitioners is on the sixth floor Dr. Naik and Dr. Merchant, the two Doctors who served the college staff selflessly for several years seem to have retired quietly during this academic year.

We are proud to state that ours is the only college that possesses its very own health centre to cater to the medical needs of the students and the staff members of the college. It is visited by a team of doctors of repute on honorary basis. Even the Government Colony residents take advantage of the services of our health centre.

Health check up of all the Junior college students and the teaching and non-teaching staff is conducted each year. Complete blood count, height, weight, blood pressure, pulse, E.C.G. on request or as per requirement is conducted. LIBRARY BOOKS :

In keeping with the excellence and traditions of the college. The Library now has 30434 books on its shelves. In 1996-97 it added 559 books worth Rs. 1,26,496. It subscribes for 550 journals, magazines and periodicals as well as all leading daily newspapers.

BOOK BANK :

The College Book Bank was established in the year 1974 since then it has been helping the economically back-ward students to borrow books on a deposit of Rs. 25/- (Rs. 15/- are refunded).

On loan for one academic year, The book bank has nearly 2736 books to cater to the students' needs. The Library manages to distribute the books upon application received from the students.
