## INTRODUCTION :

The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The building now has added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since last academic year. Ever since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai.

The College has a towering structure facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi besides the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its twenty-seven illustrious years of existence. The college was proud to possess for its own use the Amar Gian Grover Auditorium for some years. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai city hold their seminars, symposiums and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past two years. It started a separate management wing in the year 1975-76 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute.

On the 2nd floor of the building (the 1st floor being non-existent) is the Principal's Office, the administrative office, and Principal's Secretariat. In the small passage are two Computer rooms, the examination boards, and the two of the Heads of Dept. of Economics & Accounts rooms. At the other end of the floor are the Library, Reading & Research Room. In the center is Principal's residence.

The two Vice Principal and Prof-in-charge students Council have their Cabins on the 3rd floor. This floor also houses the Medical Centre, Fee Collection Centre, College Co-operative store and a Store room. The fourth floor has Lady students Common Room, Physical Director's Cabin and Gymkhana room and the Canteen are situated on the 5th floor. Part of the room on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floor are lectures rooms.

The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts three professional courses : the M.M.S., M.P.B.M., M.B.A. Foundation Course of the I.C.F.A.I. and the C.A. Foundation course. Two lecture rooms are however, used by the degree college when required.

The 8th floor comprises of Management Office - two cabins for the Management Staff - Seminar room, Meeting room, placement Coordinators cabin, students Gymkhana room & the students council room for the management institute, and a computer lab.

The staff common room meetings with the Principal of the degree and junior college are held on the 6th floor. All functions like seminars workshops, etc. are also held on this floor each year.

The seventh floor comprises of the Management Library, the Reading room, the Seminar room, the Director's Office, faculty bodies & class rooms, for the management institute.

## HEALTH CENTRE

We are proud to state that ours is the only college that possesses its very own health centre to cater to the medical needs of the students and the staff members of the college. It is visited by a team of doctors of repute on honorary basis. Even the Government Colony residents take advantage of the services of our health centre.

Health check-up of all the Junior college students and the teaching and non-teaching staff is conducted each year. Complete blood count, height, weight, blood pressure, pulse, E.C.G. on request or as per requirement is conducted. ### LIBRARY REPORT - 1998-99 :-

LALA LALPAT RAI COLLEGE

The Library is a collection of written, printed, other graphic and visual materials organised and maintained for reading, study and reference. Its function is to promote learning by making both materials and services available to the students & staff members.

Reading provides a meeting of minds and hence widening of experience. So our college library has an all-round collection. It has a collection of 31551 books as on 31st March, 1999. During 1998-99 it added 540 books (including 54 reference books). It subscribed to 75 periodicals as well as leading news papers.

As a special collection for reference the library has General Encyclopedic works, Handbooks, Directories, Year Books, Biographies, Dictionaries. It also procures the reading materials to fulfill the futuristic requirements covering all branches of standard specialization of the college.

### REPORT OF THE BOOK BANK - 1998-99

College library has Book-Bank facility for the exclusive benefit of poor students of all classes. During the academic year 1998-99, twenty(20) students availed of the Book-Bank facility & one hundred eighteen(118) books have been used. The Book bank facility is mainly exploited by the economically backward students of the College.

## REPORT OF THE TEACHER-GUIDE SCHEME - 1998-99 :-

Students can approach their respective class/subject teachers in order to overcome their difficulties in academics or even non-academic spheres. The teachers also extend a helping hand willingly as far as the guidance is concerned.

For the year 1998-99, the college made an arrangement of remedial lectures for economically backward students of F.Y.B.Com. class. The students were given special guidance by teachers after their regular college hours. Students took keen interest in the subjects like Mathematics and Statistical Techniques, Business Communication, Business Economics as they found these subjects difficult to understand.

In the academic year 1998-99, 26 students attended the remedial lectures. For the year 1999-2000, around 40 students would be getting the facility of remedial lectures.

## REPORT OF THE SEMINAR- 1998-99 :

Our College organised a Seminar on 'India's Foreign Trade' on 16th January 1999.

The seminar was inaugurated by Mr. Subrat Ratho I.A.S., Joint Director General of Foreign Trade. Dr (Mrs.) Mutalik Desai, Mr. G.R. Sood and Mr. Vijay Jalan presented their papers on various aspects of India's Foreign Trade.

The valedictory address was given by Mr. Rashmi Sangoi. The Seminar was well attended by delegates from various city Colleges and the staff members of our college.

#### 9) LEPROSY ERADICATION PROJECT :

Our 46 N.S.S. volunteers participated in a campaign of

Leprosy in Koliwada Village at worli. The campaign was organised from 30th January, 1999 to 5th February, 1999. In this project volunteers conducted community survey for identifying Leprosy patients.

#### 10) Y.F.S.D. CAMP :

The college N.S.S. Unit organised Y.F.S.D. Camp at village Kanher in Ulhasnagar Tahsil of Thane District from 25th December, 1998 to 3rd January, 1999. The camp was attended by 31 student volunteers. The main activities undertaken at the camp were :

- e) An extra coaching to school children in various subjects was also given by the N.S.S. Volunteers.

#### 11) HEALTH AWARENESS :

This is the mass contact programme in the community in which we took up health survey and group of 10 volunteers, collected medicines from various Doctors at Badlapur. On 3rd January, 1999 we organised Medical Camp in which a team of 10 specialists (Doctors) were invited to check up the health of Kanher people. This medical camp was inaugurated by respected Police Patil of Kanher Village and free medicines were distributed to the public.

The Health Awareness Programme was organised in Tulsiwadi area Mahalaxmi from 31st January, 1999 to 10th February, 1999. This programme was conducted in two phases. In the first phase the NSS Volunteers conducted a survey of the people in the slum area and to identify the slum dwellers suffering from various diseases. We also collected medicines from various Pharmaceuticals Companies for the slum people. In the second phase, we conducted health check up of the people of the area and distributed medicines with the help of Doctors from the College Health Centre.

#### 12) AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME :

The N.S.S. Unit of the college observed AIDS Awareness Week from 25th November 1998 to 10th December, 1998. A group of 36 NSS Volunteers performed street play in the prominent areas of Mumbai city. 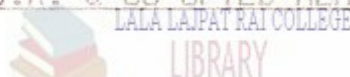
