## INTRODUCTION

The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The Building now has added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since last Academic year. Ever since its inception in 1950, the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai.

The college has a towering structure rising the skyline of the Arabian Sea, with the Marine Drive and the famous temple of Goddess Bahaiabad besides the Park Avenue spreading it on its three sides. The college has named a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its twenty-seven picturesque years of existence. The college was proud to possess for its own use the Mahar Gian Gopal Auditorium for some years. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai City hold their seminars, conferences and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past few years. It started a separate management wing in the year 1999-00 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute.

On the 2nd floor of the building - the 1st floor below non-residential is the Principal's Office, the administrative office, and Principal's Secretariat. In the small part are two lecturer rooms, the examination rooms, and the two of the Heads of Dept. of Economics & Accounts rooms. At the other end of the floor is the library - Reading & Study Room. In the center is Principal's residence.

The 3rd floor houses a Junior-Library with Principals and Vice-in-Charge of students. There are two more lecture halls on the 3rd floor. This floor also houses the Medical Centre, the college canteen, college Co-operative store and a Store room. The fourth floor has a computer centre, Physical Director's Office and Examination room. The Lajpat Rai Library is also situated on the 3rd floor. Rest of the rooms on the 4th, 5th and 6th floor are lecture rooms for the F.Y.B.A. & B.A. courses respectively.

The 5th and 6th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts three professional courses - the B.B.A., M.B.A., M.B.A. Examination Course of the I.C.M.A. and a Foundation course - M.B. The lecture rooms are however, used by the college whenever when required.

The 6th floor comprises of Management Office - two cabins for the Management Staff - Seminar room, Meeting room, Placement Coordinators cabin, students' workshouse room & the students council room for the management institute, and a computer lab.

The 7th floor common room meetings with the Principal of the degree and junior colleges are held on the 7th floor. All functions like seminars workshops, etc. are also held on this floor each year.

The seventh floor comprises of the Management Library, the Reading room, the Seminar room, the Director's Office, Faculty bodies & class rooms, for the management institute.

### LIBRARY REPORT - 1999-2000

The library is a collection of written, printed, other graphic and visual materials organized and arranged for reading, study and reference. Its function is to promote learning by making both materials and services available to the student members.

Reading provides a testing of mind; the wider the range of experience and knowledge, the more efficient the mind. The library has an all round collection. It has a collection of 2100 books as on 31st March, 2000. During 1999-2000 it added 300 books (including 20 reference books). It subscribed to 75 periodicals, as well as leading news papers.

As a special facility for reference the library has General Encyclopedic works, directories, Dictionaries, Year Books, Biographies, Bibliographies. It also procures the reading materials to fulfill the futuristic requirements covering all branches of advanced specialization of the college.

### REPORT OF THE BOOK BANK - 1999-2000

The College has also the book bank facility for the exclusive benefit of poor students. It has been running the scheme since 1999-2000, eight hundred (800) students are availing the book bank facility. Around 10000 hours have been used, the book bank has benefited the poor students of the college.

### REPORT OF THE SEMINAR- 1999-2000

The seminar was organized on subject of 'INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY - 2000' on 27th January 2000.

The venue of the seminar was the College Seminar hall on the 6th floor. Around 100 lecturers from various colleges participated in the seminar.

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. S. K. Ramakrishna M.Ed., Ph.D., director of the Govt. Institute of Technology, S.H.D.T., University and he also delivered the keynote and closing remarks. Dr. K. Srinivasan highlighted the scope of IT.

The resource person for the 1st technical session was Mr. Kamal Jain, General Manager of BSNL. In his thought provoking lecture, he focused on the important aspects of IT.

In the 2nd technical session the speaker was Dr. Arvind Chawla, Chief Information Officer, from Central Technologies. He spoke on e-commerce, and the Internet.

The seminar was well attended & co-ordinated by the economics Department of our college.

Dr. V.K. Jaiswal, Chief Editor, Lokshiksha presided over the lecture.

#### REPORT OF THE TEACHER-GUIDE SCHEME - 1999-2000

Students attend sessions with respective subject teachers in order to overcome their difficulties in academics or extra-academic spheres. The teachers extend a helping hand as far as academic guidance was concerned.

For the year 1999-2000, the various steps in arrangement of remedial lectures for academically backward students of P.U.B.Com class. The students were given special guidance by teachers after their regular college hours.
