The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The building now has added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since 1999. Ever since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai.

The College has a towering structure facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi besides the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its twenty-seven illustrious years of existence. The college was proud to possess for its very own use the Amar Gian Grover Auditorium for some years. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai city hold their seminars, symposiums and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past two years. It started a separate management wing in the year 1995-96 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute.

On the 2nd floor of the building (the 1st floor being non-existent) is the Principal's Office, the administrative office, and Principal's Secretariat. In the small passage are two Computer rooms, the examination rooms, (and the two of the Heads of Dept. of Economics & Accounts rooms.) At the other end of the floor are the Library, Reading & Research Room. In the center is the Principal's residence.

The Senior College & Junior College Vice Principals and Prof-in-charge of students' Council have their Cabins on the 3rd floor. This floor also houses Fee Collection Centre, College Co-operative stores and Store rooms. The fourth floor has Lady students' Common Room, Physical Director-cum-Jr. college Supervisor's Cabin with in the staff common room. The Canteen is situated on the 5th floor. Rest of the rooms on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floor are lecture rooms for the F.Y., S.Y. & T.Y.B.Com. classes. Class rooms have been reshaped/rebuilt to accommodate growing demand and increasing number of students demand for the Commerce stream.

The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts three professional courses : the M.M.S., M.P.B.M., M.B.A. Foundation Course of the I.C.F.A.I. the C.A. Foundation course & B.M.S.

The 6th floor comprises of the Management Office - two cabins for the Management Staff - Seminar room, Meeting room, placement Coordinators cabin, students Gymkhana room & the students' council room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory

The staff common room meetings with the Principal of the degree and junior colleges are now held in the staff Common Room. All functions like seminars workshops, etc. are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor.

The seventh floor comprises of the Management Library, a Reading room, the Seminar room, the Director's Office, faculty bodies & class rooms, for the management institute.

1) The Medical Centre has now been shifted to the college compound/ground floor of the college building. The degree and Jr. College staff common room is now fully airconditioned - gifted by the Alumni Association of the college to the staff members on the Teachers day on 5th September 2000.

In this health check up, we conducted complete blood count, height, weight, blood pressure and pulse etc. Our Doctors give services like allopathy, Homeopathy and accupressure to the staff, students and the general public. LIBRARY REPORT - 2000-2001 - M. Fadli

The Library is a collection of written, printed, other graphic and visual materials organised and maintained for reading, study and reference. Its function is to promote learning by making both materials and services available to the students & staff members.

Reading provides a meeting of minds and hence widening of experience and knowledge. So our college library has an all-round collection. It has a collection of 32134 books as on 31st March, 2000. During 2000-2001 it added 583 books including 22 reference books. It subscribed to 75 periodicals as well as leading news papers.

As a special collection for reference the library has General Encyclopedic works, Handbooks, Directories, Year Books, Biographies, Dictionaries. It also procures the reading materials to fulfill the futuristic requirements covering all branches of standard specialization of the college.

REPORT OF THE BOOK BANK - 2000-2001 - Mrs V.V Bhide

Our College Library also has Book-Bank facility for the exclusive benefit of poor students of all classes. During the academic year 2000-2001, eighteen(18) students availed of the Book-Bank facility & one hundred eighteen(118) books have been used. REPORT OF THE SEMINAR- 2000-2001 - Prof K. Gopkumar

The Lala Lajpat Rai College organised a Seminar on 'WTO and Global Business;' on 20th Jan. 2001, from 10.00 am to 5.30 pm.

The NSS Unit organised the following projects during the year :-

Our programme officer conducted an orientation course for the students enrolled in the NSS for the academic year 2000-2001. The aims and objectives of the NSS were explained to the volunteers and they were motivated to take up various projects to be organised in the academic year 2000-2001.
