ANNUAL REPORT

The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading Educational institutions in the metropolis. The building has added 'The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management' since 1999. Ever since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai. The College has a towering structure facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi besides the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its thirty-one illustrious years of existence. The college is proud to possess Amar Gian Grover Auditorium. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai city hold their seminars, symposiums and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past thirty-one years. It started a separate management wing in the year 1995-96 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute. Our college introduced the BMS (three year integrated degree course) in the year 1999-2000 and B.Sc.-IT (three year integrated degree course) in the year 2001-2002. Similarly B.Sc. (Computer Science) was also started in the year 2002-2003. Post graduate degree courses i.e. M.Com. and M.Sc. (Computer Science) were started from this academic year 2002-2003.

On the 2nd floor of the building (the 1st floor being non-existent) there are the Principal's Office and the College/administrative office. On the opposite of the Principal's and administrative office there are examination and cyclostyling rooms besides two rooms used as Trust office and cabins of Vice-Principals of Sr. College and Jr. College. At the other end of the floor are the Library, Reading & Research Rooms. In the center is the Principal's residence.

The third floor houses students' Council Room, fees collection centre, store rooms, 5 class rooms, peons' room and the college gymkhana room. The fourth floor has Lady students' Common Room and the staff common room. The Canteen is situated on the 5th floor. Rest of the rooms on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floors are lecture rooms for the F.Y., S.Y. & T.Y.B.Com. classes. Class rooms have been reshaped/rebuilt to accommodate the growing demand and increasing number of students for the Commerce stream from year to year.

The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts professional courses : the M.M.S., P.G.D.B.M., M.B.A. Foundation Course of the I.C.F.A.I and the C.A. Foundation course. B.M.S. and the B.Sc.-IT are housed on the 5th floor too.

The 6th floor comprises of the Management Office - two cabins for the Management Staff - Seminar room, Meeting room, placement Coordinators cabin, students Gymkhana room and the students' council room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory. The 7th floor has cabin for the visiting faculty and a well equipped Library for Management students.

The staff common room meetings with the Principal of the Degree and Jr. Colleges are now held on the 6th floor. All functions like Seminars, Workshops etc are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor.

The sports director Prof. S.N. Bhagwat who is also the Jr. College Supervisor was shifted from the staff Common Room to the 3rd floor. The co-ordinator for BMS course Mrs. Vijaya Gangal was allocated a room for her official use as many visitors, Students and the Faculty members come to meet her from time to time. The College cooperative store has been shifted to the ground floor of the building. Also added on the ground are an extra Xerox centre, a fast food joint and an Archie's Card & novelty gift store and kiosks for the security staff.

The seventh floor comprises of the Management Library, Reading room, the Seminar room, the Director's Office, faculty bodies & class rooms, for the management institute.

The Medical Centre has also been shifted to the ground floor of the college building. The degree and Jr. College staff common room is now fully air conditioned - gifted by the Alumni Association of the college to the staff members on the Teachers day on 5th September 2000.

The academic year 2002-2003 witnessed the beginning of the Pearl Anniversary celebrations of the college.

The Health Centre undertakes Health Check up for all the Junior College students. In the health check up, the complete blood count, height, weight, blood pressure, pulse etc. of all students are verified and recorded. Our Doctors render services in allopathy, Homeopathy and accupressure to the staff, students and the general public. The Government Colony residents very often avail of the services of the Doctors at the Health Centre, Which has now laid down a nominal charge of Rs. 20/- for one week's medicine. There is also a visiting counsellor for the students.

Library Report

Reading provides a meeting of minds and hence a widening of knowledge and experience. Our College Library has more than 33750 books and other reading materials to fulfil the futuristic requirements and covering all branches of standard of specialization of the college. The Library subscribes to 80 periodicals as well as leading newspapers.

The library has established, promoted, and maintained a range of quality services that support the college's mission and goals. The Library is competent and continues to live up to the expectations of all its its users. Timings of the library are reasonable and convenient for the students and members of the staff. Reference and other special assistance are also made available when the college's primary users most need them.

Library has been providing varied, authoritative and up-to-date resources that support its mission and the needs of its users. It provides quality resources in the most efficient manner possible. Collection of current and vital Information Technology (IT) books, journals etc. have been added and old outdated books journals etc are weeded out regularly. REPORT OF SEMINAR ON 'IS DISINVESTMENT AN ANSWER TO THE ILLS OF
THE INDIAN ECONOMY' (24th & 25th Feb. 2003)

A thought provoking Seminar on the above topic was organised for 2 days divided into 4 technical sessions with two leading resource persons speaking on different aspects of Dis-investment. Dr. N.A. Majumdar, former Principal Advisor, R.B.I. inaugurated and presided over all the technical sessions. Dr. R.H. Patil, Chairman, Clearing Corporation of India Ltd., delivered the Key note address. Principal M.G. Shirahatti introduced and welcomed both the dignitaries of the inaugural session. Principal Shirahatti felt that the Seminars were like refresher courses where the professors from the faculties of commerce and Economics familiarize themselves with the burning economic issues like Dis-investment. He also informed the participants how Mr. Arun Shourie has been making a move to hand over the management of PSUs to the Private Sector. This has opened up discussion of the pros and cons of Dis-investment and hence the materialization of the present Seminar.

Dr. R.H. Patil in his Key note address stated that Indian Economy is plagued by many diseases. Curing just one ill will not cure the entire economy. Indian history is replete with the theme of private sector dominating the Indian economy. The Government's role was then confined to maintaining Law and Order. In the early days entrepreneurship flourished and companies like HMT and BHEL prospered and made profits. However, Dr. Patil felt that one should not put political ideology before economic aspects but one can prioritize the role of the government like maintaining a strong judiciary that will dispense with cases and look after the infrastructure.

Dr. R.N. Patil expressed that the right appraisal to the problem of disinvestment is not to view the issue of privatization of the financial sector as related only to the Central Government, but be made relevant to the State Government also. The angle of the debate of privatization should be made a) more efficient with the right utilization of resources primarily b) efficiency of Management c) The unit should function in the interest of all the stake holders and not merely for the benefit of labour and a few bureaucrats sitting in Delhi.

If PSU can be given autonomy strengthened with resources, they will definitely prosper as good if not better than their private counterparts.

Dr. N.A. Majumdar, former Principal Advisor R.B.I. had strong views. He said that private sector was no paragon of virtues nor was the P.S.U. an abode of vices. It is a myth


are not rare, frauds camouflaging of accounting figures led to the boom of capital market in U.S.A.

India is committing a major blunder in imitating U.S.A. PSUs can flourish provided the right talent, healthy environment, attitude and approach are adopted, because earlier the slogan was 'the commanding heights of the economy should be in the public Sector'. This has proved to be false but even the other extreme can be disastrous. The IDBI image was so good that every foreign country sent their representative to study its working. Today it has become 'sick' because of the autonomy. There are as many cases of competition mismanagement in the private sector as in the public sector.
