#### REPORT ON THE SEMNAR

Life will certainly not be the same for the forty odd students who attended the Seminar on Life skills presented by Dr. Ms. Suman Kapur on the 20th December 2002. Dr. Suman comes from the group 'Health horizons' which conducts personality development programmes for individuals and groups. They specialise in performance enhancement, Personality development, skills for success in life, enrichment and rehabilitation.

Dr. Suman commenced her epoch-making speech with the statement that I.Q. is no longer a bench mark for success. Manya pure 1908 high I.Q. have been miserable failures in life. Also there is a presence of increased conflicts and stresses and strains in modern living. The number of murders and crimes is also on the increase. Man's most distinguished asset is his brain.

She explained the reasons why certain people do well in life while others are miserable failures. The answeer lies in correct use of life success skills? I.Q. merely predicts school grades, job succes and gets one in a profession. It is not cognitive intelligence, apatitude and achievement.

Events do not cause stress but how a human being reacts to them does. Most people suffer from something called chronic fatigue syndrome. Also 8 % of all illnesses are psychomatic. Stress occurs when demands on an individual exceeds his adjustment resources and is believed to have delirous effect.

Most individuals can be classified in to either Type A or Type B groups. Hurried speech, constant rapid movements in eating, thinking and performing several things at one and the same time and no compassion for other are the main characteristics of Type A personalities. On the other hand Type B individuals are completely at variance with this Type A types. Aristotle once said 'Any one can become angry. That is easy. But o be angry with the right person in the right degree and at right time is very difficult.

Most people are like pressure cookers, they blow up steam on the slightest pretext. Dr Kapur also said that happiness is like a butterfly. The more you chase it the more it runs away from you, but if you are still, remain steady, it silently comes and rests on you shoulders. A pessimist makes difficulties of opportunities while an optimist does exactly the reverse. A successful person is one who lays the foundation with the bricks others throw at him.

Dr. Suman concluded by saying the following;
"If you want happiness for an hour take a nap
If you want happiness for a day - go on a picnic
If you want happiness for a week - go for a vacation
If you want happiness for a year - inherit wealth and squander it
If you want happiness for a life time enroll life success skills"

Thus one should enroll in 'Health Horizons' for a life time of health solutions.

The Seminar concluded with a brief vote of thanks. Students were asked to avail of the services of Dr. Suman who is available as the college counsellor every Tuesday in our college Health centre.

#### THE ROTARY EXPERIENCE

It was indeed a week to cherish and remember for the 20 odd Rotarians of Lala Lajpat Rai College who visited the Institute of Medical and Physical Rehabilitation at Haji Ali from the 25th of November 2002 to 30th of November 2002. The main idea behind the project was to learn about how people who are physically challenged do their best and want to be valued for what they are and hence require appreciation rather than sympathy or charity.

During the course of the week the students visited the various departments of the Institute and had a close interaction with the heads of the departments, Doctors and patients.

Some of the departments we visited and the interaction that consequently followed is reported below:

We met Dr. Regge the H.O.D. of the occuational therapy department which concerns itself with upper nurological problems and extremity problems; also physiotherapy within the lower and uppeer extremity.

The practitioner evaluates checks, plans and prescribes exercises medication for all orothopedic disabilities. Patients are referred to by the R.T.O. If the extent of disability exceeds more than 40 % especially for students, then such students are given concession certifiction for extra time during exams or are perhaps advised to avail the services of a scribe. Workers who suffer silent injuries in companies also refer the patients to the Department. The neuro Motor Unit of the Institute deals with Pediatric and Adult cares and the injuries of the brain and the spinal cord. The perculiarity of the brain. The peculiarity of the brain is that the brain cells do not undergo replacement when the brain is affected unlike the dermatological cells. When skin is bruised, new skin appears. But any damage to the brain affects the entire system, the brain cells don't recuperate. The unit dealt with cereberal palsy cases where deformity happens before birthile, the problems

are genetic. Such patients are rehabilitated. Such conditions are observed normally in a child who doesnot attain the normal maturity bnecause the brain has not developed.

Such cases can be either CP diaplygics - those which have only feet developed. One hand affected monoplgics. One side affected - hemiplgic.

Such patients are required to use aids calypers. A few cases of Down's syndrome which is a severe case of mental retardation especially whose MR components are affected were treated by the Institute. The near motor unit section was under the able administration of Dr. Vichaka. The orthopedic department receives patients from the OPD or physiotherapy departments. This department as the suggests deals with deformity of the bones - basically makes callipers for patients with disabilities of the foot.

We also visited the prosthetic and orthopedic workshop wherein we saw how workers made callipers for patients affected iwith polio. Unilateral for those affected on one foot and bilteral for those whose both feet were affected. Manufacturers of the above basic components was LIMCO company. The department also dealt with cases of amputation especially those involving artificial limbs. A positive mould was made and covered with lamination. Besides the unit also made poly uretheric foam foot and ealt with disorders involving prosthetic knee joints.

The visit to the centre truly proved inspiring and our young rotract members gained a fund of knowledge and first hand experience infollows the opposition when the physically handicapped deserve our moral support, encouragement and appreciation.

## JUNIOR COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT 2002-2003
