Our Gymkhana activities started with Foot ball practice in the month of July 2003, under the able guidance from Mr. Derek D'Souza and Mr. Mitra, our Foot ball coaches. Both the teams from Jr. & Sr. College participated in Inter-collegiate Foot ball tournament ~~and~~ commendably.

Our Jr. College Cricket team performed very well under the guidance of Shri Padmanabha Bankapure. The team reached the final in C.K. Naidu Inter-collegiate Cricket tournament organised by District Sports authority of Mumbai in the month of August 2003. The same team reached the Semi Final in the Inter collegiate Cricket Tournament conducted by Junior college sports association of Mumbai in the month of December 2003/January 2004. Mr. Omkar Gurav of SYJC showed excellent performance at both the tournaments. He was selected for Police shield tournaments and he was awarded the 'Best wicket keeper' prize.

Mr. Omkar Gurav was selected by the Mumbai Cricket Association in under 17 years team. He played for Vijay Merchant Trophy tournament for 3 days' match. These matches were played against Gujarat, Saurashtra, Maharashtra and Baroda. In the month of January 2004, he also played for Vijay Hazare all India Knock-out tournament at Vishakhapattanam.

Mr. Bhavesh Patil from Jr. College also put up a good performance in the Inter-collegiate Cricket tournament. He was also selected for Mumbai Cricket team under 17 years. ANNUAL REPORT – 2003-2004
