ANNUAL REPORT

2004 – 2005

The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The building has added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since 1999. Ever since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai. The College has a towering structure facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi besides the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai - the Lion of Punjab through its three decades of its illustrious existence. The college is proud to possess Amar Gian Grover Auditorium. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai city hold their seminars, symposiums and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past thirty-three years, it started a separate management wing in the year 1998-99 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute. Our college first introduced the PGD BM than the BMS along with the three year integrated degree course B.Com. in the year 1999-2000 and B.Sc.-IT in the year 2001-2002. Similarly B.Sc. (Computer Science) was also started in the year 2002-2003. Post graduate degree courses i.e. M-Com and MSc. (Computer Science) were started from die academic year 2002-2003 and B.M.M from 2004-2005. Additional subject like Insurance & Banking, Financial Management & Accounting, Tours Travel & Tourism Management, for B. Com Students were introduced during this academic year. These courses are all run simultaneously from morning to evening.

On the 2nd floor of the building, there are the Principal's Office and the College/administrative office. On the opposite side of the Principal's and administrative office there are examination and cyclostyling rooms besides two rooms used as Trust office and cabin of Vice-Principals of Sr. College and Jr. College. A full fledged Management College administrative office has been added from 2004-2005. Our Accountant Shri C.R. Joshi has been assigned a separate cabin in the Management Office, as he manages all the accounts of the Management Institute as well as the original degree college. At the other end of the floor are the Library, Reading & Research Rooms. Our Library is fully equipped and is extended to accommodate more students for studying and has also added computers. The reader will learn more about it in the library Report given later. Students are allowed to use these for accessing information through Internet. In the center is the Principal's residence.

The installation of Goddess  Sarawati's idol is an ideal and appropriate spot is noteworthy. As the students come up the staircase and the staff members on their way to the 2nd lift, pass by it; they bow their heads and pay respect to the Goddess of knowledge and learning. A separate air-conditioned office for the unaided courses has been added. The cultural officer Mr. Kapil Kapoor occupied a table in this room upto 15 March. He has now been shifted to occupy a separate Room which originally was the examination Room - next to-in-charge Principal Chaudhari's Room. He also looks after the needs of the Management college

The third floor houses the Prof In-charge of Student's Council, Prof S.N. Bhagwat, Vice-Principal of Jr. College-cum-Physical Director (Gymkhana Incharge), the fees collection centre, store rooms, 5 class rooms, peons' room and the college gymkhana room. It also houses the cabin of the Students' Council In-charge. The fourth floor has turned

the Lady students' Common Room into a class room, and the staff common room. The Canteen on the 5th floor is now shifted to the ground floor, as class rooms were needed for the management courses. Rest of the rooms on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floors are lecture rooms for the F.Y., S.Y. & T. Y.B. Com. and B.Sc. Comp. & IT classes. Class rooms have been reshaped/rebuilt to accommodate the growing demand and increasing number of students for the Commerce stream and management courses from year to year. The fourth floor staff room has now provided an access for the examination answer-papers' room as the small tutorial rooms used so far were needed for special management subject exams. On the third floor we have added a Gymnasium from this year for the staff members and students. It was inaugurated in March 2005.

The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts professional courses : the M.M.S., P.G.D.B.M., MBA Foundation Course of the I.C.FAI. and the CA Foundation course. B.M.S. and the B.Sc.-IT are housed on the 5th floor too. The first batch of BSc IT appeared for the University Exams last academic year along with our M.com Pt II students.

The 6th floor comprises of the PGDBM is Administrative Office - two cabins for the Management Staff, Seminar room, Meeting room, placement Coordinators cabin, students Gymkhana room and the students council room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory. The 7th floor has cabins for the visiting faculty and a well equipped Library for Management students. There are special cabins in the Library for the important visiting faculties.

The staff common room meetings, the Staff academy seminars of the Degree and Jr. Colleges are held on the 6th floor In fact, all functions,

Seminars, Workshops of the Institute are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor, which is now renamed "Conference Hall".

The College cooperative store has been shifted to the ground floor of the building. Also added on the ground floor are an extra Xerox centre, Health center, Canteen and fees paying centre. The boxers use the premises for their practice and training. The Health center is on the mezzanine floor. Entry to the Health center is from the Library staircase. The central Bank is at the most convenient place - again on the mezzanine floor, the entry of which is near the main lift of the college Building.

The BMC has widened the sea-side road and has now built a wall which caused great inconvenience to the staff and students as the gate and the stairway had not been rebuilt until the beginning of the academic year 2004-2005. Moreover no proper road was paved. The entrance of the college was full of debris and stones, and the ground was completely uneven. Thanks to our College Principal Dr. MG. Shirahatti, gates with 2 proper staircases have now been built from 2nd term onwards and now all the lady staff and students feel safe to enter the college premises. The only improvement needed is a banister as the steps are of black stone and of narrow width, and likely to be slippery during the rains.

The Medical (Health) Centre has also been shifted to the ground floor of the college building. The degree and Jr. College staff common room is now fully air conditioned -gifted by the Alumni Association of the college to the staff members on the Teachers day on 5th September 2000. The college flooring has acquired a new look They are shining with white marbles - which, if well maintained will prove very healthy and impressive.

The academic year 2004-2005 witnessed plenty of changes even in the administrative structure. We now have an In-charge Principal (no Vice-Principal Prof D.C. Chaudhari who also looks after the Management courses along with Ms. S.K. Garg assisting him in managing the "non-aided" or 'self financed courses".

The College Administration:

The I/C Principal very effectively executed the policy of involving the teacher members with administrative work of such nature as would complement their daily academic work. The coordination of academic and administrative work ensured a smooth working of the college. Attempts are made to evolve a system by which all members of the teaching staff are entrusted with academic and administrative tasks.

The Strength of the College :

The total strength of the college as its roll calls bear out is 3125 students comprising of 1369 students in the Junior College and 1756 students in the degree college. The strength of the college as compared to the earlier years has increased as the College has full fledged management courses running simultaneously. The simple Laia Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics, of yesteryears has

grown into a proudly proclaimed "Lala Lajpat Rai Education Complex". The new course in Bachelor in Information Technology (B.Sc.-IT) was introduced from last academic year. This year has added 120 students in M.Com. Part -1 and 80 in M.Com. Pt.II.

THE COLLEGE HEALTH CENTRE [2004-2005]

LIBRARY REPORT

2004 - 2005

During the academic year 2004-2005, 700 new books (approximately) have been added to the previous collection of 34000 books. As on 05th March 2005, according to accession register there are 34751 books on record. The Library subscribes to 87 periodicals (Journals and Magazines) including free periodicals and has approximately 50 educational CDs.

The Free Internet Facility was introduced in the library from this academic year for our students and staff members. On an average almost 25 students used the Internet facility everyday. The College

Library catalogue has also been made accessible through the intranet in Lala Lajpat Rai Institute campus. Our Library staff oriented the students and teachers on how to access the catalogue on web OPAC. This year our library started a Current Awareness Service (CAS) through e-mail for our library users. Important subject based information is delivered through this service. Most of the students welcomed this service.

The Library has started the digitization of syllabus, question papers and other scholarly articles. These important sources were accessed through the "Greenstone Digital Library" a digital library software developed by Newzealand The e-articles are also made available on different subjects through this Software. Users find it very easy to search and retrieve the information.

The Library services and activities cannot be provided without an efficient co-operation and performance by all the library staff members. Our library always seeks to provide quality service with excellent team work.

The student who reads the maximum number of books other than the prescribed textbooks and who uses the maximum number of resources from the library during the academic year is awarded the "Best Library Users' Prize". REPORT OF N.S.S. ACTIVITIES DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR
2004 – 2005

The N.S.S. Unit started its activities by enrolling students for N.S.S. We enrolled 50 students as N.S.S. volunteers for the year 2004 – 2005.

The N.S.S. Unit organized various programmes and projects during the year 2004-2005. Programme Officer of NSS organized an orientation course for the students enrolled in the NSS for the academic year 2004 – 2005. The aims and objectives of the NSS were explained to the volunteers and they were also motivated to take up following Campus and university level projects for the Academic year 2004 – 2005.

CAMPUS PROJECT :

1. Independence Day Celebration :

On 14th August NSS Volunteers presented patriotic songs and dance in the auditorium to celebrate the eve of Independence Day. On 15th August, 2004 they participated in the Flag – hoisting ceremony in the

college premises: On 15th August 2004, flags from Hi-Tech Family Enrichment Foundation were sold out and Rs. 1000/- was deposited with the foundation to help the disabled persons.

2. Blood Donation Camp :

A blood donation camp was organized on 1st September 2004 in the college Auditorium Foyer with the help and in collaboration with K.E.M. Hospital, Parel, Mumbai. Around 80 students of our college donated blood to help the needy.

3. C.E.R. Health and Health & Hygiene And AIDS awareness campaign :

A survey was conducted to find out the number of residents who take treatment from the college health center. The NSS volunteers also performed a street play on AIDS among people of the slums by distributing leaflets and putting up posters in the locality.

4. Collection for Tsunami Relief Fund :

A project was undertaken by the NSS Unit of the college for the people affected by the Tsunami Catastrophe affecting the Southern India. The NSS Unit of the college collected Rs. 1,770/- for the relief fund and submitted the same to the University of Mumbai.

5. Celebration of Republic Day :

On 26th January, 2005 we celebrated Republic Day by participating in the Flag hoisting ceremony in the college premises and by distributing flags and flag sticker to the poor children of the slum area.

Y.F.S.D. Project :

Our college conducted a 10 days Rural Camp at Kanhor Village near Badlapur in Thane District, from 26th December, 2004 to 4th January, 2005. A brief report of the activities conducted during the camp are as follows :-

- ◆ Total number of students were 23
- ◆ The daily schedule of camp would start at 6.30 and end at 7.00 p.m. i.e., waking up, breakfast, shramanubhav, bath, lunch, guest lecture, group discussion, community visit, street play, dinner, review of the day's work and finally light off.
- ◆ Shramanubhav would start from 9.30 am to 12.00 noon, Our NSS volunteers undertook and completed shramanubh activities in the area of Kanhor village on 26th, 27th and 28th December, 2004.

Under Shramanubhav the volunteers at the camp had undertaken various activities such as Tree Plantation, Road Cleaning, Village Visits etc. and organizing village meeting and guest lectures and discussion on various subjects including cultural programmes and classes on Meditation and Yoga.

Leadership Training Camp :

Our students Manoj Bhat and Mahesh Prammar participated in the Leadership Training Camp of NSS volunteers conducted by the NSS Unit of Mumbai Cell, at Mulgaon (Ambarnath) from 5th August to 9th August, 2004. These students were nominated as Honorary Secretaries of NSS for the year 2004 - 2005.

1. Intercollegiate Patriotic Song Competition :

The patriotic song competition was organized by the NSS Unit in the college premises on 24th August, 2004, As many as twelve colleges from the zone participated in the competition, the programme was a grand success, Our college was awarded the 1st prize.
