ANNUAL REPORT

2005-2006

The Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in the metropolis. The building has added "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" since 1999. Ever since its inception in June 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It has thus carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai. The College has a towering structure facing the expanse of the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi besides the Race Course escorting it on its three sides. The College has proved a fitting memorial for the great son of India Late Lala Lajpat Rai – the Lion of Punjab through its three decades of its illustrious existence. The college is proud to possess Amar Gian Grover Auditorium. It is now being given for public functions too and leading institutions of Mumbai city hold their seminars, symposiums and conventions on week-ends. The auditorium is also used by our management institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past thirty-three years, it started a separate management wing in the year 1998-99 when the sixth & seventh floors were entirely given away to the Management Institute. Our college first introduced the PGD BM then the BMS along with the three years integrated degree course B.Com. in the year 1999-2000 and B.Sc.-IT in the year 2001-2002. Similarly B.Sc. (Computer Science) was also started in the year 2002-2003. Post graduate degree courses i.e. M.Com. and M.Sc. (Computer Science) were started from the academic year 2002-2003 and B.M.M. from 2004-2005. Additional subjects like Ecommerce, Insurance & Banking, Financial Management & Accounting. Tours, Travel & Tourism Management, for B.Com.,

students were introduced during this academic year. These courses are all run simultaneously from morning to evening.

On the 2nd floor of the building, near are the Principal's Office and the College/administrative office. On the opposite side of the Principal's and administrative office there are examination and cyclostyling rooms besides two rooms used as Trust office and cabin of Vice-Principals of Sr. College and Jr. College. A full fledged Management College administrative office has been added from 2004-2005. Our Accountant Shri C.R. Joshi has been assigned a separate cabin in the Management office, as he manages all the accounts of the Management Institute as well as the original degree college. At the other end of the floor are the Library, Reading & Research Rooms. Our Library is fully equipped and is extended to accommodate more students for studying and has also added computers. The reader will learn more about it in the library Report furnished in later pages. Students are allowed to use these for accessing information through Internet. In the centre is the Principal's residence.

The Installation of Goddess Saraswati's idol in an ideal and appropriate spot is noteworthy. As the students come up the staircase and the staff members on their way to the 2nd lift, pass by it; they bow their heads and pay respect to the Goddess of knowledge and learning. A separate air-conditioned office for the unaided courses has been added. The cultural officer Mr. Kapil Kapoor has occupied a table in this room upto 15 March. He has now been shifted to occupy a separate Room which originally was the examination Room next to In-charge Principal Chaudhari's Room. He also looks after the needs of the Management college.

The third floor houses the Prof. In-charge of Student's Council. Prof. S.N. Bhagwat, Vice-Principal of Jr. College-cum-Physical Director (Gymkhana In-charge), the fees collection centre, store rooms, 5 class rooms, peons' room and the college gymkhana room. It also houses the cabin of the Students' Council In-charge. The girls' common room in the fourth floor has been restructured into a class room, and Peons' common room. The Canteen on the 5th floor is now shifted to the ground floor, as class rooms were needed for the management courses. Rest of the rooms on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floors are lecture rooms for the F.Y., S.Y. & T.Y.B.Com. and B.Sc. Comp. & IT classes. Many Class rooms have been reshaped / rebuilt to accommodate the growing demand and increasing number of students for the Commerce stream and management courses from year to year. The fourth floor Teachers' staff room contains a small store room to store examination stationaries. Earlier it was kept in the small tutorial room. On the third floor we have started Gymnasium from this year for the staff members and students as well. It was inaugurated in March 2005.

The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts professional courses like - the M.M.S., P.G.D.B.M., M.B.A. Foundation courses of the I.C.F.A.I. and the C.A. Foundation course. B.M.S. and the B.Sc.-IT are housed on the 5th floor too. The first batch of B.Sc. IT appeared for the University Exams last academic year along with our M.Com. Pt.II students.

The 6th floor comprises of the PGDBM Administrative Office, two cabins for the Management Staff, Seminar room, Meeting room, placement Coordinators' cabin, students' Gymkhana room, the students council room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory. The 7th floor has cabins for the visiting faculty and a well

equipped Library for Management students. There are special cabins in the Library for the important visiting faculties.

The staff common room meetings, the Staff academy seminars of the Degree and Jr. Colleges are held on the 6th floor. In fact, all functions, Seminars, Workshops of the Institute are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor, which is now renamed as “Conference Hall”.

The College co-operative store has been shifted to the ground floor of the building. Apart from that the ground floor has an extra Xerox centre, Health Center, Canteen and fees paying centre. Our Student boxers use the premises for their practice and training. The Health Center is on the mezzanine floor. Entry to the Health Center is from the Library staircase. The Central Bank is at the most convenient place – again on the mezzanine floor, the entry of which is through the main lift of the college Building.

The Medical (Health) Centre has also been shifted to the Mezzanine floor of the college building. The college flooring has acquired a new look with the addition of white marbles. Which, if well maintained will prove very healthy and impressive.

The academic year 2005-2006 witnessed a change even in the administrative structure. We now have an In-charge Principal, Prof. D.C. Chaudhari.

Mr. Kapil Kapoor is the co-ordinator for the non-aided or self financed courses.
