During the year 2005-2006 approximately 808 (includes General + Textbooks) new books are being added. There are 35407 books. As per 31st March 2006 accession register report. Library subscribes 80+ periodicals (Journals and Magazines) including free periodicals and has approximately 100 educational CDs.

The Free Internet Facility was started in the library from last academic year to all students and teachers and same is continued. Average 30 students are using the internet facility everyday. College library catalogue can be accessible through the intranet in Lala Lajpatrai Institute campus.

The Library has started the **digitalization** of syllabus, question papers, scholarly articles. these important sources can be accessible through the “Greenstone Digital Library” a digital library software developed by Newzeland. The e-articles are also made available on different subjects through this software. Users can find it very easy to search and retrieve the information.

The **Web Resource Centre** started in the library is successfully working for the benefit of students and teachers. In this centre users can get many important Websites, Directories and Subject Gateways etc. through which they can access the scholarly information. Librarian is assisting in accessing the information through internet.

The Library services and activities are just not possible without the sound co-operation and performance of all the library staff members. what the library provides today - a quality service is due to our Team Work.

The “**Best-Library User of the Year 2005-2006**” prize, which is given combined to the students of junior and senior college. Student who read more number of academic books other than textbooks and who use the more resources from the library during the year is awarding Best Library User. This academic year Ms. Aarti M. Parab T.Y.B.Com. (Roll No. 8683) student was awarded best library user of the year.

BOOK BANK

The book bank facility is available in the college for poor students . During this academic year (2005 -06) Ten (10) students have utilized Sixty Four (64) books to keep with them for full academic year . These students have also utilized library reference sources . They are allowed in exchange of books which they need in the middle of the academic year. Library has provided the reading materials on students need basis. These students are given free Xerox facility in the library.
