Lala Lajpat Rai College of Commerce & Economics is one of the leading educational institutions in South Mumbai. The building has been added with “The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management” since 1999. Ever since its inception, in June 1972, the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. It has, thus, carved a niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai. The beautifully architected building of the College faces the Arabian Sea, with the shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi. The extensive spread of the Race Course serves as one of the Land Mark borders. The College is a profound memorial of the great hero of India, Late Lala Lajpat Rai (the Lion of Punjab). Our college also possesses the Amar Gian Grover Auditorium, which facilitates public functions such as seminars, symposiums and conventions on Week-ends. The auditorium is also being used by our Management Institute for its prime academic activities.

The college has undergone many changes in the past thirty-five years. A separate management wing was started in the Year 1998-99 and the sixth & seventh floors were given to the Management Institute. Our college first introduced the PGDBM and then the BMS alongwith the three years Regular integrated degree course in commerce i.e. B.COM., in the year 1999-2000, B.Sc.-IT was started in 2001-2002. Similarly B.Sc. (Computer Science), Post Graduate degree courses i.e. M.Com. and M.Sc. (Computer Science) were started from the

academic year 2002-2003. B.M.M. from 2004-2005. Additional subjects like E-Commerce, Insurance & Banking, Financial Management & Accounting, Travel & Tourism Management, to B.Com., students were introduced during the same academic year. All these courses go simultaneously from morning to evening.

The two important offices of the college - Principal's office and the Administrative Office including the Trust Office are placed on the 2nd Floor of the college. At the other end of the floor there are the Library, Reading & Research Rooms along with two lecture rooms in between. Our Library is fully equipped and has been extended to accommodate more students for studying. The Library is completely computerised. Students use these computers for accessing information through internet. The installed Goddess Saraswati's idol at the entrance of the 2nd floor adds positive ambience of learning. The 3rd floor houses separate cabins for Senior college Vice-Principal along with Law College Principal and college Counsellor. There are some lecture rooms on the same floor. Apart from these, the floor also accommodates the Gymnasium and Girl's Common Room. The fourth floor has been restructured into a Computer Lab for the Senior College Practicals. The same floor has Teachers' Common Room too. The 5th floor is now completely allocated as class rooms for the management courses. The Lecture rooms on the 3rd, 4th and 5th floors are for the F.Y., S.Y. & T.Y.B.Com. and B.Sc Comp. & IT Classes. Many lecture rooms have been reshaped / rebuilt to accommodate the growing demand and increasing number of students for the

Commerce and management stream. Teacher's Staff Room houses separate cabins for the HODS. On the 4th floor near the lift there is an Examination room where Examination activities are conducted. The 6th and 7th floors are for the Management Institute which conducts professional courses like – the M.M.S, P.G.D.B.M., M.B.A, Foundation courses of the I.C.F.A.I. and the C.A. course. B.M.S., B.M.M. the B.Sc.-IT are housed on the 5th floor.

The 6th floor comprises of the PGDBM Administrative Office, two cabins for the Management Staff, Seminar room, Meeting room, Placement Coordinator's Cabin, Students' Gymkhana Room, the Students' Council Room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory. The 7th floor has cabins for the visiting faculty and a well equipped Library for Management students. There are special cabins in the Library for the important visiting faculties.

The staff common room meetings, the Staff Academy Seminars of the Degree and Jr. College are held on the 6th floor. In fact, all functions, Seminars, Workshops of the Institute are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor, which is now renamed as "Conference Hall"

The college co-operative store has been shifted to the ground floor of the building. Apart from that the ground floor has an extra Xerox Centre, canteen and fees paying counter. Our Student boxers use the open premises opposite to the

canteen for their boxing practice and training. The Health Centre is on the Mezzanine floor. Entry to the Health Center is from the Library staircase. The Central Bank is also the most convenient place again on the mezzanine floor, the entry for which is through the main lift of the college Building. The college flooring has acquired a new and polished look with the addition of white marbles and painting in every floor. Principal Dr. S.N. Shetti is the 4th Principal of the college who succeeded our previous Principal Dr. Alakananda K.R. on October, 2007
