Our H.S.C. result for the year 2007-2008 is 96.18% with 343 First Class, 201 Second Class and mere 35 Pass Class. Miss Bhavana Kumari Jain stood 1st in our College with 81.33%. Mr. Prathamesh Hanumant Yadav 2nd with 81.17% and Miss Mamatha Narsayya Ambala stood 3rd with 80.50%. The F.Y.J.C. result for the year 2006-2007 is 88.73% with 46 1st Class, 303 IInd Class & 210 Pass Class. Credit goes to our well experienced and dedicated team of Teachers who are behind these results.

Here in this college, we impart education in totality i.e. we aim at the personality development of our students along with the academic results. This mammoth task is achieved with the help of various associations of academic and cultural activities. During the year 2007-2008, 376 books and 492 Textbooks were added. There are 36223 books as on 15th March 2008 according to our accession register. Library subscribes 75+ periodicals and has approximately 180+ educational CDs.

The *Free Internet Service* was initiated in the year 2004-05 to all students and teachers to empower in finding the web resources and the same has been continued for the year 2007-08. In an average 40 students use the Internet facility everyday.

Library books catalogue (from the year 1980 to till date) can be accessed through the intranet in college camp. The bar-coding of the books is completed and the *Barcode Technology* is implemented for the circulation of the books.

The Library has finished the *digitization* of syllabus and question papers of all courses for the year 2007-08. Now the digitization has been continued for the changed syllabus.

This academic year *Best - Library User of the Year 2007-2008* has been awarded jointly to Ms. Deepika A Jain T.Y.B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), (Roll No. 56417) and Ms. Sarita J Verma T.Y.B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), (Roll No. 56444).

This year *Scanning and CD/P VI) burning facilities* are extended to students along with Photocopying and Printing facilities provided in the Library.

BOOK BANK

The book bank facility is available in the college for the poor students. During this academic year i.e. 2007-08 Eight (08) students have utilized Fifty Five (55) books to study for full academic year. These students have also utilized the Library reference sources. They re allowed to exchange books which they need in the middle of the academic year. Library has been providing the reading materials to students on their need based.
