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About Lala Lajpat Rai College

Named after the great freedom fighter and martyr – the Lion of Punjab, who was also a great Academic and Social Reformer, the Lala Lajpatrai College of Commerce and Economics at Haji Ali, Mahalaxmi was established in 1972, to perpetuate the memory of the great patriot i.e. Lala Lajpat Rai. This college actually was the outcome of a short interaction between the former managing Trustee Late Shri Ram Prasad Gupta and Mr. Lal Bahadur Shastri, then the Union Industries Minister in 1959 at Late R.P. Gupta's Residence in Bombay (Mumbai). Ever since its inception in 1972 the college has been growing through its various phases in different spheres of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. With the addition of "The Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Management" in 1999 the simple Lala Lajpat Rai College of yesteryears have grown into a mighty Lala Lajpat Rai Educational Complex. Thus carving a special niche for itself, gaining prominence and eminence among the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai.

The beautifully architected building of the college faces the Arabian Sea, with the Shrine of Haji Ali, and the famous temple of Goddess Mahalaxmi. The extensive spread of the Race Course serves as one of the Land Mark borders. Above all the college itself is a profound memorial of the great hero of India i.e. Late Lala Lajpat Rai.

On the ground floor our college houses Canteen which provides quality food to its staff and students at a concessional rates along with a photo copy cum stationary shop. The administrative office has been shifted to the ground floor, while the mezzanine floor has the extension branch of Central Bank of India and Staff's Common Room for the unaided section's faculties.

The college has undergone many changes since last 36 years. This year the entire college has been renovated completely. The new look of the college seems to hint at that – “The Change is truth and Universal”. The new look of the college actually flaunts the new spirit of its staff and students.

The 6th and 7th floors of the college is given to the Lala Lajpat Rai Management Institute where the full fledged lectures for MMS, PGDBM, MFM, MMM and MHRDM are conducted. The 5th floor is given to the self-finance courses where the lectures for BMS, BAF, BBI, BMM, B.Sc.IT, and B.Sc.Comp.Sci. are conducted while on the 3rd and 4th floor lectures are taken for the Three Years’ Degree courses (B.Com.) of the Aided Section and Two years’ Master Degree Course in Commerce (M.Com.)

The Principal’s office, Trust office and the Unaided Section’s Administrative office are placed on the 2nd floor. At the other end of the same floor there are College Library, Reading Hall, Research and two lecture Rooms situated in between. Our Library is fully equipped with books and journals and has been extended to accommodate more students in the Reading Hall. The entire library has been computerized since past three years. Our students use these computers for accessing information through internet. The installed Goddess Saraswati’s idol at the entrance of the 2nd floor adds a very positive spirit and ambience of learning to the college.

The 3rd floor houses separate cabins for Senior and Junior college Vice-Principals along with Law College Principal and college counselor. There are lecture rooms for B.Com. on the same floor. Apart from these, the floor also accommodates the Gymnasium and Girls’ Common Room along with a Store Room in one corner.

The 4th floor with little renovation and restructure has added a Computer Lab for the Senior College Practicals. Along with the lecture rooms the floor also has the Staff's Common Room for teachers.

The 5th floor is entirely allocated as class rooms for Self-finance courses while the lecture rooms on 3rd and 4th floors are for F.Y., S.Y. T.Y.B.Com. and M.Com. lectures.

The 6th floor comprises of the PGDBM Administrative Office, two cabins for the Management Staff, Seminar Room, Meeting Room, Placement Coordinator's Cabin, Students' Gymkhana Room, the Students' Council Room for the management institute, and a computer laboratory. The 7th floor has cabins for the visiting faculty and a well equipped Library for Management students. There are special cabins in the Library for the important visiting faculties.

The staff common room meetings, the Staff Academy Seminars of the Degree and Jr. College are held on the 6th floor. In fact, all functions, Seminars, Workshops of the Institute are held in the Seminar Room on the 6th floor, which is now renamed as "Conference Hall".

The college flooring has acquired a new and polished look with the addition of white marbles and painting in every floor while the renovation work is still in progress.

THE COLLEGE ADMINISTRATION

Principal Dr. S.N.
